- Hearing loss affects 1 in 6 New Zealanders.
- Around 11% of New Zealand's workforce is Deaf or hard of hearing.
- A lack of hearing loss awareness can impact productivity, health and safety, and can lead to work-related stress.
- Many employees are not aware they have a hearing loss. Out of 100 employees recently screened, 50% were referred for a full assessment.

What's included?

Each workshop runs for 1 hour and is delivered to your team by NFDHH and partners.

Hearing Screening

On-site hearing screenings are included as part of your first workshop. We recommend you book both on the same day.

Screenings are delivered via iPad kiosks. These self-service screening stations are an excellent way for your whole team to check their hearing.

Workshops are available face-to-face in Auckland and virtually across New Zealand.
